NARCAN TRAINING & CERTIFICATION



Participants learn to recognize, respond to and reverse a suspected opioid overdose using intranasal naloxone (Narcan), and how to obtain naloxone for their use as rescuers.

MEMBER INSIGHTS

" My life has been very hard, I feel very happy to have come this far. I was living on the streets for almost 2 years, I was in 6 different programs, I was arrested 5 times, I was in jail for a year and a half, and it was so crazy that hearing myself go to jail was something that gave me a lot of motivation to change, the judge was close to sentencing me to 3 to 7 years in prison. My lawyer from Queens Defender gave me the opportunity to come to DYC and it was the best thing that has happened in this life. I am working in construction, I have my own room, I am paying my own bills, and I had the opportunity to pursue my GED in Restart Academy. We are a program that supports each other in good times and bad. "

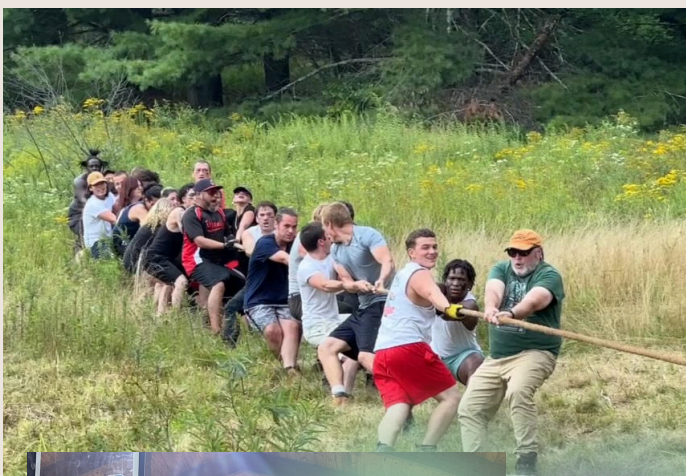

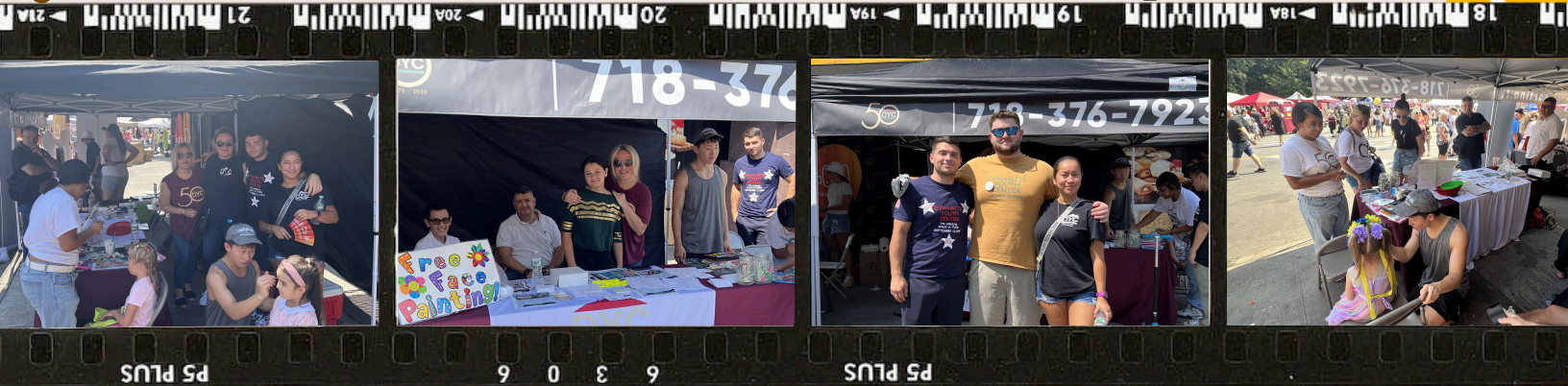

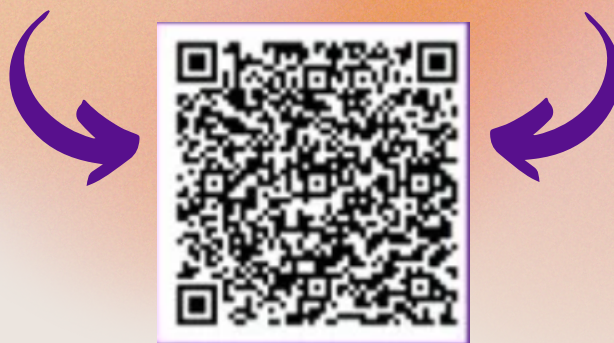
